Focal Truth:

Whoever hears and believes in Jesus Christ crucified is saved from their sins.

Observations:

- Telling the story of Jesus Christ crucified is the gospel. 1 Cor. 1:17
- 2. Telling the story of Jesus Christ crucified is the power of God. 1 Cor. 1:18
- 3. Telling the story of Jesus Christ crucified saves believing sinners. 1 Cor. 1:21
- Telling the story of Jesus Christ crucified pleases God. – 1 Cor. 1:21
- 5. Telling the story of Jesus Christ reveals the power and wisdom of God. 1 Cor. 1:24

Things to Remember:

- 1. The best news comes in the worst news that Jesus Christ must die for sinners.
- 2. God's power comes as the message of the cross is shared with others.
- 3. God is greatly pleased when the message of the cross is being shared with others.
- 4. Jesus Christ is glorified when they tell the story of His death on the cross.
- 5. God's power to save comes to those who believe in Christ crucified.

Daily Use:

- 1. Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures praise Him for His grace.
- 2. Tell someone this week that Jesus Christ died for sinners.
- Rejoice that you have been saved by hearing and believing the message of the cross.
