Focal Truth:

Godly parents live in the fear of God and teach their children the fear of God.

Observations:

- 1. The fear of God is a holy emotion of those who are in Christ. Pr. 1:7
- 2. The fear of God is the holy emotion of loving reverence, submission and obedience to God as Father. Pr. 1:7
- 3. The fear of God is the beginning of knowledge. Pr. 1:7
- 4. Godly parents live in the fear of God before their children. Gen. 31:42,53

Things to Remember:

- 1. Godly parents live in the fear of the Lord in the presence of their children.
- 2. Godly parents living in the fear of God bring good to their children and children's children.
- 3. Children learn the fear of God from godly parents living in the fear of God.
- 4. Only those who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ will fear God.
- 5. Fearing God is the first lesson of Godly knowledge for children.

Daily Use - Family Challenge:

- 1. Parents, examine yourself do you live in the fear of the Lord?
- 2. Parents, talk to your children about why fear of God is a good thing.
- 3. Parents, watch for the fear of God to rise in the hearts and minds of your children as they come to follow Jesus.
