⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.

Focal Truth:

Godly parents trust in the Lord and teach their children to trust Him.

Observations:

- 1. Godly parents <u>dependently trust</u> in the Lord and teach their children to dependently trust in the Lord.
- 2. Godly parents <u>exclusively trust</u> in the Lord and teach their children to exclusively trust in the Lord.
- 3. Godly parents <u>completely trust</u> in the Lord and teach their children to completely trust in the Lord.
- 4. Godly parents live in the assurance of God's promises and teach their children to live in the assurance of God's promises.

Things to Remember:

- 1. Trusting God is a way of living, not just a one time decision.
- 2. Trusting God is an act of the surrender of the will to the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. The godly live with assurance that God is working in all the circumstances of their lives!
- 4. Only God knows the best paths for the godly

Daily Use - Family Challenge:

- As parents trust in the Lord with all your heart believe in the Lord Jesus Christ!
- 2. As parents don't rely on your own understanding, know God is working in your life situations.
- 3. Talk with your children about trusting God, not trusting in themselves.
- 4. Talk with your children about how God has directed and provided for your family as you have trusted Him.
- 5. Lead your children to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.
