⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.

Focal Truth:

Godly parents trust in the Lord and teach their children to trust Him.

Observations:

1. Godly parents dependently trust in the Lord and teach their children to dependently trust in the Lord.
2. Godly parents exclusively trust in the Lord and teach their children to exclusively trust in the Lord.
3. Godly parents completely trust in the Lord and teach their children to completely trust in the Lord.
4. Godly parents live in the assurance of God's promises and teach their children to live in the assurance of God's promises.

Things to Remember:

1. Trusting God is a way of living, not just a one time decision.
2. Trusting God is an act of the surrender of the will to the Lord Jesus Christ.
3. The godly live with assurance that God is working in all the circumstances of their lives!
4. Only God knows the best paths for the godly

Daily Use – Family Challenge:

1. As parents – trust in the Lord with all your heart – believe in the Lord Jesus Christ!
2. As parents – don't rely on your own understanding, know God is working in your life situations.
3. Talk with your children about trusting God, not trusting in themselves.
4. Talk with your children about how God has directed and provided for your family as you have trusted Him.
5. Lead your children to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.
