Focal Truth:

Godly parents avoid sexual sin and teach their children to avoid sexual sin.

Observations:

- 1. Godly parents avoid the temptations to sexual sin and teach their children to avoid them. Pr. 5:3
- Godly parents know the bitterness and danger of committing sexual sin and teach their children about the bitterness and danger of it. – Pr. 5:4
- Godly parents understand that sexual sin leaves lifelong consequences and teach their children this truth. – Pr. 5:8-14

Things to Remember:

- 1. Do not go near the house of adultery. Pr. 5:8
- 2. Adultery starts in the heart. Matt. 15:19
- 3. Adultery happens when we are attracted and yield to the flattering, attractive stranger.
- 4. Uncontrolled sexual desires lead to sexual sin. 1 Pet. 2:11
- 5. You cannot cover up adultery! Everyone will know about it!

Daily Use - Family Challenge:

- 1. Remove yourself from dangerous relationships that tempt you to sexual sin.
- 2. Resist the stranger who flatters you and tells you things that are pleasing to you.
- 3. Talk to your children about the importance of faithfulness in marriage.
- 4. Flee youthful lusts. 2 Tim. 2:22
