<sup>3</sup> For the lips of an adulteress drip honey, and her speech is smoother than oil; <sup>4</sup> But in the end she is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a two-edged sword.

### **Focal Truth:**

Godly parents avoid sexual sin and teach their children to avoid sexual sin.

# Observations:

1. Godly parents avoid the temptations to sexual sin and teach their children to avoid them. - Pr. 5:3
2. Godly parents know the bitterness and danger of committing sexual sin and teach their children about the bitterness and danger of it. – Pr. 5:4
3. Godly parents understand that sexual sin leaves lifelong consequences and teach their children this truth. – Pr. 5:8-14

# Things to Remember:

1. Do not go near the house of adultery. – Pr. 5:8
2. Adultery starts in the heart. – Matt. 15:19
3. Adultery happens when we are attracted and yield to the flattering, attractive stranger.
4. Uncontrolled sexual desires lead to sexual sin. – 1 Pet. 2:11
5. You cannot cover up adultery! Everyone will know about it!

## Daily Use – Family Challenge:

1. Remove yourself from dangerous relationships that tempt you to sexual sin.
2. Resist the stranger who flatters you and tells you things that are pleasing to you.
3. Talk to your children about the importance of faithfulness in marriage.
4. Flee youthful lusts. – 2 Tim. 2:22
