## **Focal Truth:**

You shall not steal from your neighbor.

### 1. The thief is a taker.

 The taker is controlled by desires to take from others. – Gen. 3:6, Matt. 15:19

 The taker uses deception to take from others. – Gen. 31:19, 34-35; Lev. 19:11

 The taker delights in the act of taking from others. – Josh 7:1,21, John 12:6

#### 2. What does a taker take?

- They steal possessions.
- They steal from employers and employees. –
  Pr. 11:1, Tit. 2: 9-10, James 5:4
- They cheat on their taxes and they steal from the citizens. – Rom. 13:7
- They do not repay their debts. Ps. 37:21
- They commit adultery.
- They rob God. Mal. 3: 8-9

## 3. The taker can become a giver.

Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much." Luke 19:8

He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with one who has need. Eph. 4:28

- Kill the sin of stealing by the help of the Holy Spirit.
