Matthew 12:15-21

¹⁵ But Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. Many followed Him, and He healed them all, ¹⁶ and warned them not to tell who He was.

¹⁷ This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet:

¹⁸ “BEHOLD, MY SERVANT WHOM I HAVE CHOSEN; MY BELOVED IN WHOM MY SOUL IS WELL-PLEASSED; I WILL PUT MY SPIRIT UPON HIM, AND HE SHALL PROCLAIM JUSTICE TO THE GENTILES. ¹⁹ “HE WILL NOT QUARREL, NOR CRY OUT; NOR WILL ANYONE HEAR HIS VOICE IN THE STREETS. ²⁰ “A BATTERED REED HE WILL NOT BREAK OFF, AND A SMOLDERING WICK HE WILL NOT PUT OUT, UNTIL HE LEADS JUSTICE TO VICTORY. ²¹ “AND IN HIS NAME THE GENTILES WILL HOPE.”

Focal Truth:

I hope in God because Jesus is the Savior of the world.

Observations:

1. Jesus Christ is the hope of the nations. –
Matt. 12:21
2. Jesus Christ is the light of the nations. – Luke 2:32
3. Jesus Christ is the Savior of the nations. –
Luke 2:10-11

Things to Remember:

1. There is only one name that saves from sin – Jesus Christ the Lord.
2. Jesus Christ saves the hopeless who live in hope.
3. The darkness of sin in the mind is removed by the light of Jesus Christ.
4. Oh, what a Savior – Jesus Christ the Lord!
Worship Him, honor Him, glorify Him!

1. Look to Jesus Christ and live in joyful hope!
2. Tell your friends Jesus Christ can give them hope in their hopelessness.
3. Praise the name of the Lord Jesus – the Savior of the nations!
