

Matthew 5:13-14

¹³ "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men. ¹⁴ You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden."

Focal Truth:

Believers are dead to the world yet living in godliness in the world.

Observations:

- 1. The believer lives in the flavorless world with godly saltiness. Matt. 5:13
- 2. The believer lives in the darkness of the world as godly light. Matt. 5:14-15
- 3. The believer lives in the selfishness of the world doing godly good deeds, glorifying God. Matt. 5:16

Things to Remember and Do:

- 1. Let others see Jesus in you!
- 2. The unbelieving world needs the godly believer in the world.
- 3. Let your light of good deeds shine in the world.
- Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God. – Heb. 13:16
