Focal Truth:

Unless you are born again you cannot enter the kingdom of God.



Observations:

Things to Remember:

1. You must be born again – this is the truth that lasts!
2. Those who are born again do not practice sin – they overcome it. – 1 John 3:9
3. Those who are born again believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. – 1 John 5:1,5
4. Those who are born again overcome the world by faith in God. – 1 John 5:4
5. Those who are born again are protected by God from the evil one. – 1 John 5:18
6. Those who are born again hopefully live by the resurrection of Jesus Christ. – 1 Pet. 1:3

Daily Use:

1. Put your faith in Jesus Christ – you must be born again!
2. Come to Jesus Christ, the Light – confess your sinfulness to Him.
3. Rejoice believer in your second birth!
