

Jesus Christ Our High Priest

Hebrews 5:5-10

Hebrews 5:5-10

⁵ So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, "You are My Son, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU"; 6 just as He says also in another passage, "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK." 7In the days of His flesh, He offered up both prayers and supplications with loud crying and tears to the One able to save Him from death, and He was heard because of His piety. ⁸ Although He was a Son, He learned obedience from the things which He suffered.

⁹ And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation, ¹⁰ being designated by God as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

Focal Truth:

Jesus Christ is the perfect High Priest.

Observations:

- 1. Imperfect men served as high priests for Israel. Heb. 5:1-4
- 2. Jesus Christ is the perfect and eternal High Priest because God appointed Him. Heb. 5:5-10
- 3. Jesus Christ is the perfect and eternal High Priest because He suffered and became the sacrifice for sins while on the earth. Heb. 5:7-10

Things to Remember and Do:

- God has provided the church with an eternal and perfect High Priest – Jesus Christ the Lord.
- 2. All praise to our eternal and perfect High Priest Jesus Christ the Lord. Rev. 1: 5-6
